

2026 SNOW SCULPTURES CALL FOR PROPOSALS





Festival du Voyageur 2026 Call for Snow Sculpture Proposals

In celebration of winter, and the *joie de vivre* of the French language and culture, Festival du Voyageur is seeking proposals of sketches. Designs and ideas of snow sculptures to enhance the look and feel of our winter festival site.

Proposals deadline: **Monday, November 3, 2025**

Emerging, or professional artists and teams are invited to submit their interest by submitting fully rendered sketches or images of mockups of their ideas, indicating which project they are applying for.

Design proposals are open for the following projects (artists can apply for more than one project):

- 1) **Snow Playground Slide** (2 available): A snow block that is approx. 10x10x12 built at an angle including two culverts as a slide for children to use in the park.
- 2) **Snow Sculpture with ladder** (3 available): Snow structures that can be interacted with for youth of all ages. Safety must be taken into account. Must not include counter levers, over hanging pieces, or any snow that is climbable, or that can fall on a park patron.
- 3) **8x8x8 Snow Sculpture in Parc du Voyageur** (2-4 available): Proposals for embellishment pieces within the park. This is great for a team of 2 members.
- 4) **4x4x4 Snow Sculpture or Snowfa in Parc du Voyageur** (2-4 available): Proposals for embellishment pieces within the park. This is great for a team of 2 members.
- 5) **Commercial Public Art Blocks 8x8x8** (availability is dependant on sponsors): Ideal for teams of 2-4. These sculptures are sponsored by commercial companies in Winnipeg. If you have a company that would like to support your project, please let us know so we can communicate with them as well.

We are excited and happy to hear all your project ideas. Please reach out for more information and details about each project that is available prior to applying to ensure successful submissions.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Dates and Location

The Snow Sculpture carvings typically take place 1 month to a few weeks before the Festival begins. The exact date will be coordinated once the projects have been selected. Carve dates are approximately **Jan 12 to Feb 12, 2026** in Whittier Park, in Saint-Boniface, as well as in various locations within Winnipeg depending on the project. Once your carving is started, you will be given one week (1) to complete your project.

Festival 2026 Theme

Through the Frosted Window – explore the magic of transformation, where snowy surfaces reveal hidden worlds and new perspectives

Selection Criteria

Proposals are open to all emerging artists and teams, or professionals who already have some experience with snow and the ephemeral. The teams will be selected according to the following criteria:

- The originality and visual interest of the chosen subject
- The utilization of the snow block provided
- The physical and artistic qualities of the proposed sculpture
- Team members' experience in sculpture (not applicable on smaller projects)
- Previous experience in ephemeral materials (not applicable on smaller projects)

Proposal Method

There are no proposal fees. Each artist or team must complete the following:

- A proposal form completed with all the pertinent information
- A precise, rendered drawing of the sculpture or a clear rendered image of a maquette, and a description of the concept. (Photos of a scale model will also serve the purpose)
- Photos of previous sculptures (snow or other medium) or other 3D projects created by the members of the team (please include dimensions of the artwork)
- A description of the experience of the artist and/or the team members

The proposals form must be completed and received by the Festival du Voyageur office by **Monday, November 3, 2025**.

Block Dimensions

The dimensions of each block are noted on the available projects above. All sides of the block should be sculpted, as the public will have access to all sides of the sculptures. All blocks will be formed with natural "Manitoba" snow, unless otherwise advised.

Equipment and Services Provided by Festival du Voyageur

The sculptors must provide their sculpting tools. The Festival du Voyageur will not provide a heated rest shelter, toilets or tools unless previously discussed or requested. The Festival du Voyageur is happy to advise on where to get access to tool. A lending library of tools may be available, depending on timing.

Electric and mechanical tools are prohibited. Sculptors should bring their own finishing tools. Water and snow are the only materials allowed in the construction of the sculpture. Ice will be permitted but not provided. No other support materials will be permitted.

Clothing

Winter clothing will not be provided by the organization. All sculptors are responsible for adequate winter clothing for the conditions including outerwear (jackets and pants) boots, warm socks, mitts, and toques.

Insurance and Work Safety

Each participant must insure they have proper medical insurance before beginning sculpting and will be required to submit proof of insurance before the start date to the coordination team. You will be required to provide your Manitoba Health Card number or equivalent. The Festival du Voyageur inc. will not be held responsible for healthcare claims, theft or losses or damages incurred during the contract. Each participant is responsible for their own as well as the safety of the other participants and the public. A safety orientation session as well as a signed waiver will be required from each participant. The festival reserves the right to remove any sculpture that they determine to be a safety hazard, and sculptors are responsible for the safe design of their sculpture.

Volunteer, Compensation, Accreditation

Each team member listed below will receive an accreditation to attend Festival 2026. Please let us know if this is a volunteer proposal or if an artist fee is requested. Potential fees will be determined by the size of the project, and the experience of the team members or artists in question. Fees are negotiated with the Festival du Voyageur's Snow Sculpture Coordinator, after a project has been selected to move forward.
