Fur Trade Life at Fort Gibraltar

May 19-June 26

Grade Levels: **1-12**

Length: **90 Minutes**

Maximum Group Size: **60 students**

During their visit to Fort Gibraltar, your students will discover the ins and outs of the early 19 century fur trade. Encounter costumed interpreters who portray the colourful characters of fur trade society. Learn how the fur trade was shaped by kinship ties with Indigenous trading partners at the Forks. Meet the clerk in charge of assessing the quality and value of the different furs. Listen to a voyageur retell tall tales about his travels in the North-West. Observe the tradesmen applying saws to wood and hammers to iron and help day labourers packing provisions for brigades heading west.
